







# Empowering Innovators in the Digital Age




# Guiding Founders Every Step of the Way








# "My FYP, My Startup — Turning Ideas into Ventures"



The session guided participants on how to view their academic work not just as a requirement for graduation, but as a foundation for real-world business ventures. Students learned practical tools to validate their ideas, shape them into viable business models, and explore mentorship and funding opportunities

For many, it was an eye-opener — shifting their perspective from "just completing a project" to "launching a startup that can solve real problems." # From Karachi to Riyadh: The Journey of Creative 3D

- Founded by Bilal Afridi, Creative 3D set out with one mission: to democratize manufacturing technology and empower creators. Starting at NIC Karachi, the team spent years building, testing, and refining their vision, even when resources were scarce. Their persistence soon paid off, as Creative 3D not only managed the production and distribution of locally developed 3D printers but also became a leader in providing advanced 3D printing services in Pakistan.
- Along the way, milestones marked their journey: winning NIB-III, recognition from the President of Pakistan, and the launch of the 3D Printed Gallery, all of which established them as a force in the country's tech ecosystem.

With the incubation of Creative 3D Arabia at KSU CODE Lab, King Saud University, the company took its vision global. After a five-year struggle, Creative 3D became the first Pakistani startup officially incorporated in Saudi Arabia with 100% ownership in 3D Printing & Robotics, securing a prestigious MISA license under Creative 3D Arabia.










# YOUR FYP YOUR DIRECTION
